By email dated June 24, 2022, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than July 8, 2022. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to furnish the requested information, including a certificate of good standing from the Virginia State Corporation Commission and a completed agent designation form. In addition, applicant's response to the other issues raised in the acceptance email is not signed as required by the Commission's email and Commission Rule No. 4-05.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of O2 Medical Transportation LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
