By application filed May 17, 2023, applicant requests that the legal name appearing on Certificate No. 3531 be changed from Highland Non Emergency Transportation LLC to Highland Transportation LLC. The application was accompanied by the original Certificate No. 3531, issued December 9, 2022.

Under Regulation No. 54-08, the Executive Director may approve an application to change a legal name not involving a transfer of authority. Legal name applications shall include proof of legal change.

Applicant is a Maryland limited liability company. Records obtained from the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation indicate that applicant changed its name to Highland Transportation LLC as of April 19, 2023. In support of its request, applicant has submitted a certificate of good standing issued by the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation in applicant's new legal name.

Accordingly, the application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order, Certificate of Authority No. 3531 shall be reissued to Highland Transportation LLC, 8456 Charmed Days, Laurel, MD 20723-5610.

2. That applicant may not transport passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District pursuant to this order unless and until applicant's certificate of authority has been reissued as amended in accordance with this order.

3. That applicant is hereby directed to file the following documents and present its revenue vehicle(s) for inspection within the 180-day maximum permitted in Commission Regulation No. 66: (a) evidence of insurance pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58; (b) an original and four copies of a tariff or tariffs in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 55; (c) a vehicle list stating the year, make, model, serial number, fleet number, license plate number (with jurisdiction) and seating capacity of each vehicle to be used in revenue operations;

(d) a copy of the for-hire vehicle registration card, and a lease as required by Commission Regulation No. 62 if applicant is not the registered owner, for each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; and (e) proof of current safety inspection of said vehicle(s) by or on behalf of the United States Department of Transportation, the State of Maryland, the District of Columbia, or the Commonwealth of Virginia.

4. That the approval of amendment herein shall be void and the application shall stand denied upon applicant's failure to timely satisfy the conditions of reissuance prescribed herein.
