Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 14 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$3 million, excess of \$2 million, WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on July 1, 2024, without full replacement. WMATC received a \$1 million, excess of \$4 million, replacement endorsement on June 28, 2024, but did not receive any endorsement(s) for the tier between \$2 million and \$4 million in coverage required by Regulation No. 58. As a result, Certificate No. 14 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 20,813, served July 1, 2024.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$2 million, excess of \$2 million, WMATC Insurance Endorsement on July 3, 2024, and tendered a \$100 online credit card payment on July 2, 2024. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted in accordance with Regulation No. 58-13, and this investigation is terminated.
