By application filed December 4, 2025, applicant seeks a certificate of authority to transport passengers in irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District, restricted to transportation in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Under Regulation No. 67-01, all applications for irregular route authority must be accompanied by a \$300 filing fee. The check tendered by applicant in payment of the filing fee and deposited in the Commission's checking account has been returned unpaid with the notation "CLOSED ACCOUNT."

Applicant's failure to pay the filing fee constitutes a failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements. Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.¹

Under Regulation No. 67-07: "A \$25 fee shall be charged for each payment made to the Commission by check, money order, credit card, or debit card that is later returned, reversed, or otherwise dishonored." Accordingly, applicant now owes a \$25 dishonored payment fee under Regulation No. 67-07.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of Nexus Medical Transit, LLC, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.

2. That the \$25 dishonored payment fee shall remain due.
