This matter is before the Commission on the request of respondent for an extension of time to comply with Order No. 21,622, served November 7, 2025, which revoked Certificate No. 3613 and assessed a civil forfeiture of \$3,250 against respondent for transporting passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District on six days while Certificate No. 3613 was suspended and respondent was uninsured and on one day while respondent was adequately insured but Certificate No. 3613 was still suspended.

Respondent tendered a \$250 money order on December 29, 2025, and has requested an extension of time to pay the remainder of the forfeiture in equal monthly installments of \$250. The request cites respondent's inability to pay the full forfeiture at this time.

The Commission has approved payment plans in the past after acknowledging the carrier's "good faith" down payment.¹ Accordingly, the requested extension is hereby granted. Respondent shall pay the remaining \$3,000 in 12 monthly installments of \$250 each. Each installment shall be due on the 15th day of the month beginning February 15, 2026.
