By email dated January 8, 2026, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than January 22, 2026. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to furnish the requested information, including a current certificate of good standing from the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation. In addition, applicant's agent designation form is incomplete.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of All-American Healthcare Solutions L.L.C., trading as AAHS Career Institute, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
