By Order No. 2369, served September 14, 1982, the Commission instituted an investigation to determine if respondent Louis Miller, doing business as National Capital Tours was engaging in the for-hire transportation of passengers between points in the Metropolitan District with out there being in effect an appropriate certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission.


On September 23, 1982, Mr. Miller consulted the Commission's Associate General Counsel. Subsequently, Mr. Miller acknowledged under oath the illegality of operating without a certificate, and he agreed to cease and desist from further unauthorized operations. Further, Mr. Miller agreed to entry of this order.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Louis Miller is hereby directed to cease and desist, directly or indirectly, from engaging in the transportation for hire of passengers between points in the Metropolitan District unless and until there is in effect therefor a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by the Commission authorizing such operations.

2. That Case No. MP-82-12 is hereby discontinued.
