By Order No. 2407, served April 20, 1983, the Commission instituted the above-captioned investigation and directed, inter alia,

2. That any person having an interest in this proceeding file an original and five conformed copies of their comments thereon, in writing and (where factual matters are asserted) under oath, no later than Friday, May 27, 1983, and such evidence and comments should be specifically directed to the questions and issues raised in this order. [Emphasis supplied.]

On May 6, 1983, the president of the Washington Area Limousine Association filed a written request (which we shall interpret as a motion) for a 60-day extension of time to file comments.

In support of its motion the association states that it is newly formed, and that it has not had sufficient time to analyze Order No. 2407, determine its position thereon, and formulate its comments.


For good cause shown, the association's request for extension will be granted. Further, the same extension shall apply to any other person desiring to file comments.
