
Respondent's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 24 was suspended effective February 26, 1985, for failure to maintain public liability insurance. When, after 30 days, respondent had failed to produce evidence of such insurance, this matter was scheduled for public hearing to commence April 18, 1985, to determine if Certificate No. 24 should be revoked.

On April 10, 1985, respondent presented evidence of public liability insurance. However, the certificate of insurance contained certain technical defects and could not be approved. On April 17, 1985, an appropriate certificate of insurance was received and approved. Accordingly, this investigation will be terminated, the suspension of Certificate No. 24 will be lifted, the public hearing will be cancelled, and respondent will be relieved of the obligation to pay the cost of that hearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the investigation instituted by Order No. 2673, served February 26, 1985, in Case No. MP-85-04 is hereby terminated.
2. That the suspension of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 24 is hereby lifted.
3. That the public hearing in Case No. MP-85-04 scheduled for April 18, 1985, is hereby cancelled.
4. That respondent is hereby relieved of the obligation to pay the assessment imposed by Order No. 2689, served April 1, 1985.
