
By application filed May 8, 1985, American Coach Lines, Inc., ("ACL" or "Applicant"), seeks to increase and restructure its rates for services offered pursuant to Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 1.

By Order No. 2707, served May 21, 1985, ACL was directed to post notice of the proposed tariff which shows an effective date of June 8, 1985. Order No. 2707 discussed the evidence which ACL had submitted with its application and noted that the Commission staff had requested additional supporting financial information which information was received June 3, 1985.

In order that this additional information may be fully analyzed, it is necessary to suspend ACL's proposed tariff effective on the date of service of this order pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 6(a)(1).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the proposed tariff of American Coach Lines, Inc., bearing an effective date of June 8, 1985, is hereby suspended pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 6(a)(1).
