

By Order No. 2713, served June 7, 1985, and incorporated herein by reference, the above-captioned investigation was instituted pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact for the purpose of determining whether Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 64 of Yellow Bus Lines, Inc., should be revoked.
