By application filed September 5, 1986, All About Town, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport passengers in special operations over irregular routes between points in the Metropolitan District, on the one hand, and, on the other, Rosecroft Raceway in Prince George's County, Md. Applicant currently holds no operating authority from this Commission.

Applicant's proposed tariff shows round-trip per capita fares of \$6 for adults and \$3 for children age 11 and younger when accompanied by an adult. Admission to the raceway clubhouse would be provided without additional charge.

Applicant plans to use a 1986, 49-passenger coach to provide the service. The vehicle, owned by applicant, is now leased to Blue Lines, Inc. Applicant would terminate the lease, as it pertains to this vehicle, if this application were granted.

Along with its application, All About Town submitted certain financial data inappropriate to this application. Applicant will be required to submit a current balance sheet and operating statement as well as a projected statement of revenues and expenses for the proposed service.

Pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(b) of the Compact, this application must be scheduled for public hearing to determine if the applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service and to abide by pertinent regulatory requirements, and to determine if the public convenience and necessity require the proposed service.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a public hearing in Case No. AP-86-36 is hereby scheduled to commence Tuesday, October 28, 1986, at 9:30 a.m. in the

Hearing Room of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Room 314,  
Washington, D.C. 20006.


2. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, notice of this application and the hearing thereon, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Thursday September 25, 1986, and shall present at the hearing an affidavit of publication.

3. That applicant shall file an original and four copies of a complete current balance sheet and operating statement and a detailed twelve-month projection of revenues and expenses for the proposed service, no later than Friday, October 17, 1986.

4. That any person desiring to protest this application shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule No. 14, or any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall so notify the Commission, in writing, no later than Friday, October 17, 1986, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such protest or notice on All About Town, Inc., 519 - 6th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001.

5. That Applicant is hereby assessed \$300 pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact, and is directed to deliver said amount to the office of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Room 316, Washington, D.C. 20006, no later than Friday, October 17, 1986.
