By Order No. 2934, served November 14, 1986, this investigation was instituted for the purpose of determining whether the operating authority of Edwards Trucking Company, Inc., should be revoked for willful failure to comply with the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) and Commission Regulation No. 62.


On November 24, 1986, Edwards Trucking Company, Inc., by motion (letter) requested voluntary revocation of its WMATC authority. The Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) provides, in pertinent part, that any certificate ". . . may, upon application of the holder thereof, in the discretion of the Commission, be amended or revoked, in whole or in part. . . ." At stake are two contract authorizations which cannot be operated because respondent's insurance has lapsed. We will honor respondent's request.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: ' .

1. That Authorization Nos. SP-40-02 and SP-40-07 of Edwards Trucking Company, Inc., are hereby revoked at the request of the holder thereof.

2. That the investigation in Case No. MP-86-29 is hereby terminated.
