By application filed December 5, 1986, and completed January 9, 1987, Jones & Washington, Ass'n. ("transferor"), seeks approval to transfer to Jones & Washington Associates, Inc. ("transferee"), Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 116.

Certificate No. 116 authorizes the following transportation:

IRREGULAR ROUTES:

SPECIAL OPERATIONS, transporting clients of the Bureau of Community Services, Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities Administration of the District of Columbia Department of Human Services between points in the District of Columbia, on the one hand, and, on the other, points in the District of Columbia, Silver Spring, Md., and Prince George's County, Md.,

RESTRICTED to transportation in vehicles with a manufacturer's designed seating capacity of 15 passengers or less (including the driver).

Transferee is a District of Columbia corporation established in September 1986. The corporation is wholly owned by James J. Jones and R. Linwood Washington, each of whom holds 50 percent of its outstanding stock. Mr. Jones and Mr. Washington, transferor's general partners, are vice-president and president, respectively, of the transferee corporation. The corporation's balance sheet dated September 30, 1986, shows current assets of \$74,168, including \$16,085 cash, plus fixed assets after allowance for depreciation of \$35,091, and other assets of \$31,800. The balance sheet indicates current liabilities of \$37,812, long-term liabilities of \$16,599, and equity of \$86,648.

This matter comes before us pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(h) of the Compact which provides that:

No certificate under this section may be transferred unless such transfer is approved by the Commission as being consistent with the public interest.

The matter will, therefore, be set for hearing. Transferor will be required to provide notice of this application, and a date will be established for the filing of protests. In the absence of protests, transferor may, given the nature of this proceeding, request that the Commission waive public hearing and decide the matter on the pleadings.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the above-captioned matter is hereby scheduled for public hearing to commence at 9:30 a.m. on Friday, February 20, 1987, in the Hearing Room of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20006.

2. That Jones & Washington, Ass'n., is hereby directed to publish once, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, notice of the application and hearing in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission no later than Friday, January 23, 1987.


3. That applicant is directed to post in its vehicles continuously through the date of the public hearing notice of said application and hearing in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Friday, January 23, 1987.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission an affidavit attesting such publication and posting no later than Wednesday, February 11, 1987.

5. That any person desiring to protest this application shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule No. 14, or any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall so notify the Commission in writing no later than Tuesday, February 10, 1987, and shall mail a copy of such protest or notice to Mr. R. Linwood Washington, president, Jones & Washington, Ass'n., 2412 Minnesota Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20020.

6. That Jones & Washington, Ass'n., is hereby assessed \$200 pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact and directed to deliver said amount to the office of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Suite 316, Washington, D.C. 20006, no later than Wednesday, February 11, 1987.
