

By Order No. 3077, served October 2, 1987, Rosetta D. Murray trading as Murray's Non-Emergency Transport Service ("applicant") was directed to file, among other things, an affidavit of identification, a lease agreement for vehicles to be used in the proposed WMATC operations for the USDA Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, and a certificate of inspection for the leased vehicles. By motion filed October 16, 1987, applicant seeks an extension of time to comply with the aforementioned requirements. The motion states that a 21-passenger vehicle with a storage compartment is on order with an expected delivery date of October 26, 1987. */

It would be impossible for applicant to comply with the aforementioned requirements of Order No. 3077 without being in possession of the equipment required under the contract. Wherefore, good cause having been shown, the time for compliance with Order No. 3077 as to all equipment required under the contract is hereby extended to Thursday, October 29, 1987.
