Pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Sections 10 and 15 of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 65 promulgated thereunder, each Commission-authorized carrier is required to file an annual report with the Commission. Forms for the 1988 annual reports were mailed to all carriers on March 3, 1989, and were due to be filed with the Commission on May 1, 1989. To date Metro Medicab, Inc. (WMATC No. 45); David C. Pearson trading as E&H Transportation Company (WMATC No. 53); Major Lester Gorham and Jarlvis Earl Gorham trading as Scenic Sightseeing Tours, a partnership (WMATC No. 92); T&S Bus Service, Inc. (WMATC No. 109); and Dav-El of Washington, DC, Inc. (WMATC No. 123) have not filed annual reports. Accordingly, the above-named carriers appear to be in violation of the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 10.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the above-captioned proceedings are hereby instituted pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact for the purpose of determining whether the operating authorities of Metro Medicab, Inc.; David C. Pearson trading as E&H Transportation Company; Major Lester Gorham and Jarlvis Earl Gorham trading as Scenic Sightseeing Tours; T&S Bus Service, Inc.; and/or Dav-El of Washington, DC, Inc., should be suspended or revoked.

2. That Metro Medicab, Inc., is hereby made a party respondent to Case No. MP-90-02.

3. That David C. Pearson trading as E&H Transportation Company is hereby made a party respondent to Case No. MP-90-03.

4. That Major Lester Gorham and Jarlvis Earl Gorham trading as Scenic Sightseeing Tours, a partnership, is hereby made a party respondent to Case No. MP-90-04.

5. That T&S Bus Service, Inc., is hereby made a party respondent to Case No. MP-90-05.


6. That Dav-El of Washington, DC, Inc., is hereby made a party respondent to Case No. MP-90-06.

7. That the above-captioned cases are hereby consolidated for public hearing to commence Tuesday, April 3, 1990, at 9:30 a.m. in the hearing room of the Commission, 1828 L Street, N.W., Suite 703, Washington, DC 20036.

8. That Metro Medicab, Inc.; David C. Pearson trading as E&H Transportation Company; Major Lester Gorham and Jarlvis Earl Gorham trading as Scenic Sightseeing Tours; T&S Bus Service, Inc.; and Dav-El of Washington, DC, Inc., are hereby directed to appear at the above-scheduled hearing and present such evidence, if any there be, to show good cause why its (his) WMATC operating authority should not be suspended or revoked.

9. That, pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 19, Metro Medicab, Inc.; David C. Pearson trading as E&H Transportation Company; Major Lester Gorham and Jarlvis Earl Gorham trading as Scenic Sightseeing Tours; T&S Bus Service, Inc.; and Dav-El of Washington, DC, Inc., are hereby separately assessed the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100), an amount preliminarily estimated to cover the cost of each respondent's portion of the hearing transcript, and each is hereby directed to deliver that amount to the office of the Commission no later than Monday, March 12, 1990.
