By application filed June 8, 1992, Georgetown University, trading as Georgetown University Transportation Society (GUTS or applicant), a District of Columbia corporation, seeks to amend its Certificate of Authority No. 56.

Applicant's current certificate authorizes regular route operations, restricted to "students, faculty, and alumni of Georgetown University and Mount Vernon College," and irregular route operations, restricted to "Georgetown University Organizations transporting passengers as authorized by Georgetown University." Applicant has requested elimination of its regular route authority and deletion of the aforementioned irregular route restriction. Applicant also has requested that the trade name appearing on its certificate be changed to "Georgetown University Transportation Shuttle."

The Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10(b), provides that "upon application by the holder of a certificate, the Commission may . . . amend . . . the [holder's] Certificate of Authority."

GUTS's application contains information regarding, among other things, its corporate status, reasons for requesting the amendment, and newly proposed irregular route scheduled service. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.

Pursuant to Commission Rule No. 6, this order and fulfillment of its requirements will provide notice of GUTS's application to amend Certificate of Authority No. 56.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That Georgetown University, trading as Georgetown University Transportation Society, shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Monday, June 22, 1992.

2. That Georgetown University, trading as Georgetown University Transportation Society, shall file with the Commission, no later than Monday, July 13, 1992, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That any person wanting to protest the amendment of Certificate of Authority No. 56 shall do so in accordance with Commission Rule No. 13 and Regulation No. 54-04(a), and any person wanting to comment on this matter, other than by protest, shall do so in writing, in accordance with Regulation No. 54-04(a), by filing such protest or comment at the office of the Commission, 1828 L Street, N.W., Suite 703, Washington, DC 20036-5104, no later than Monday, July 13, 1992, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such protest or comment on applicant's representative, Kenneth J. Filipiak, Manager, Office of Transportation, Georgetown University, 37th and O Streets, N.W., Washington, DC 20057-9999.

4. That any person seeking a formal oral hearing on this matter shall request one in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 54-04(b) no later than Monday, July 13, 1992, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such request on applicant's representative, Kenneth J. Filipiak, Manager, Office of Transportation, Georgetown University, 37th and O Streets, N.W., Washington, DC 20057-9999.
