This proceeding was initiated on April 23, 1997, in Order No. 5062, for the purpose of investigating the failure of Bach Vu, trading as Affordable Airport Charter, to file his annual report for 1996. The order directed respondent to file his annual report within thirty days. The order also directed respondent to pay a civil forfeiture of \$100, or show good cause why a forfeiture should not be assessed, within the same thirty-day period. The order gave respondent fifteen days to file a request for oral hearing, in the alternative.


Respondent failed to respond by the May 23 deadline, and, pursuant to Order No. 5062, Certificate No. 309 was automatically suspended and respondent had thirty days to show good cause why Certificate No. 309 should not be revoked.

On June 13, 1997, respondent paid the \$100 civil forfeiture. On June 18, 1997, respondent filed his annual report for 1996 and paid the \$100 forfeiture.

For good cause shown, the suspension shall be lifted and this proceeding terminated.
