These proceedings were initiated on April 23, 1997, in Order Nos. 5062 and 5063 as a result of respondent's failure to timely pay a \$100 annual fee for 1997 and file an annual report for 1996. Order No. 5062 granted respondent thirty days to file the annual report and either pay a civil forfeiture of \$100 or show cause why a civil forfeiture should not be assessed. Order No. 5063 granted respondent thirty days to pay the annual fee and a \$100 civil forfeiture.

The orders further provided that upon respondent's failure to timely respond, Certificate No. 267 would be automatically suspended and that respondent would have thirty days thereafter to show cause why Certificate No. 267 should not be revoked.

Certificate No. 267 was automatically suspended on May 23, and over thirty days have passed since then with no showing by respondent.


Respondent's certificate of authority shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Articles IV and XII of the Compact, Regulations Nos. 60 and 67, Order No. 3601, and the orders in these proceedings.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 267 is hereby revoked.
2. That respondent is hereby directed to remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.

3. That respondent is hereby directed to file within 30 days from the date of this order a notarized affidavit verifying that respondent has complied with the preceding paragraph.
