By application filed April 28, 1999, A Ace Sun Tours Corp., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two motorcoaches. Applicant's proposed tariff contains a transfer rate and hourly rates with a minimum charge.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 18, 1999, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 8, 1999, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 8, 1999, and that copies must be served on applicant's attorney, Jeremy Kahn, Esquire, 1730 Rhode Island Avenue, N.W., #810, Washington, DC 20036.
