By application accepted for filing June 6, 2000, Atlantic Airport Shuttle, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with five vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 23, 2000, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 14, 2000, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 14, 2000, and that copies must be served on applicant's manager, Alex Caraballo, 1300 Gresham Road, Silver Spring, MD 20904.
