These consolidated proceedings are before the Commission as a result of respondent's failure to comply with the Commission's annual fee regulation, Regulation No. 67, and the Commission's insurance regulation, Regulation No. 58.

The annual fee investigation in Case No. MP-2000-33 was initiated on September 6, 2000, in Order No. 5984 as a result of respondent's failure to pay an annual fee for 2000. The order directed respondent to pay the annual fee and a \$100 civil forfeiture within thirty days or face suspension and possible revocation of Certificate No. 380.

The insurance investigation in Case No. MP-2000-53 was initiated on September 7, 2000, in Order No. 5986 as a result of respondent's failure to maintain an effective certificate of insurance on file with the Commission. Respondent's certificate of insurance was cancelled effective 12:01 a.m. on September 7, triggering the invalidation and automatic suspension of its certificate of authority under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Regulation No. 58-02. Order No. 5986, directed respondent to file a new certificate of insurance within thirty days or show cause why its certificate of authority should not be revoked. To date, respondent has filed neither.

Accordingly, respondent's certificate of authority shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact, the regulations thereunder and Order No. 5986, thereby rendering Case No. MP-2000-33 moot.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 380 is hereby revoked.

2. That respondent is hereby directed to remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.

3. That respondent is hereby directed to file within 30 days from the date of this order a notarized affidavit verifying that respondent has complied with the preceding paragraph.
