This investigation was initiated on January 9, 2001, in Order No. 6081 (initial order) for the purpose of determining whether Certificate of Authority No. 389 shall be revoked for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact and regulations thereunder.

The Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 7(f), directs each person holding a certificate of authority to comply with the Commission's insurance regulations. Commission Regulation No. 58-01 requires each carrier to maintain on file with the Commission an effective certificate of insurance.

-Respondent's certificates of insurance were cancelled effective 12:01 a.m. on January 4, 2001, triggering the invalidation and automatic suspension of its certificate of authority under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Regulation No. 58-02. Respondent was directed to file appropriate replacement certificates of insurance within thirty days or show good cause why its certificate of authority should not be revoked. To date, respondent has neither filed appropriate replacement certificates of insurance nor shown good cause why its certificate of authority should not be revoked.


Respondent's certificate of authority shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact, the regulations thereunder and the initial order in this proceeding.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 389 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:
 - a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph; and

c. surrender Certificate No. 389 to the Commission.
