By application accepted for filing August 6, 2001, LAM Associates, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.¹

Applicant proposes commencing operations with four vans. Applicant proposes conducting shuttle service between points in the Metropolitan District as specified in two contracts with the General Services Administration and one contract with the Federal Aviation Administration.

One of applicant's proposed GSA contract tariffs contains an incomplete description of shuttle service requirements. Applicant will be directed to file a complete proposal.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation and acquisition of control is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 29, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.


2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 19, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 29, 2001, an original and four copies of a complete proposed contract tariff for service under GSA Contract No. GS-10F-0200J.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is September 19, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Overton J. Gillis, Jr., 8245 Boone Boulevard, #200, Vienna, VA 22182.
