
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 653 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on December 3, 2002, and Certificate No. 653 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 6934, served December 9, 2002.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement on December 23, 2002. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
