This investigation was initiated on December 4, 2002, in Order No. 6932, after it appeared that respondent Adeyemi T. Okiji, trading as Aduras Transportation Services, had transferred his WMATC operations to respondent Aduras Transportation Services, Inc., without Commission approval. The Order directed respondents to produce documents relating to their operations in the Metropolitan District from February 27, 2002, to December 4, 2002.


Mr. Okiji responded by submitting proof of dissolution of Aduras Transportation, Inc., as of December 16, 2002, and a notarized affidavit declaring under oath that Aduras Transportation Services, Inc., never transacted business in the District of Columbia, was never used at all for any reason, never opened a checking account, and never filed a tax return.

The insurance certificates on file for Carrier No. 593 throughout the period under investigation all identify Mr. Okiji as the insured.

The record supports a finding that Mr. Okiji likely operated Aduras Transportation as a sole proprietorship during the period in question and that the corporation no longer exists. Accordingly, further investigation is unwarranted, and this proceeding is terminated.
