By application accepted for filing February 5, 2003, RA Transport Services, Incorporated, a District of Columbia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita fares for transportation to and from Union Station, the Greyhound bus terminal in downtown DC, Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport and Washington-Dulles International Airport.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 25, 2003, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 18, 2003, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is March 18, 2003, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Delores E. Armstead, 444 Riggs Road, N.E., Washington, DC 20011.
