By application accepted for filing February 25, 2003, Doc's Nursing Jobs, Inc., a Maryland corporation trading as Medical Transport Express, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains individual rates for ambulatory and non-ambulatory transportation to and from medical facilities.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

## THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

Irregular Route Operations

- 1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 20, 2003, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
- 2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 10, 2003, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
- 3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 10, 2003, and that copies must be served on applicant's director, Dr. Gibson Oriji, 807 Suffield Drive, Gaithersburg, MD 20878.
