
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 712 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

Order No. 7164, served May 1, 2003, revoked the \$1.5 million in WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent pursuant to Regulation No. 58-09, effective May 31, 2003. Respondent failed to timely file the necessary replacement WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), and Certificate No. 712 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 7232, served June 4, 2003.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on June 5, 2003. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
