
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 26 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

Certificate No. 26 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 on July 1, 2003, when respondent failed to replace the primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement terminating that date, as noted in Order No. 7282, served July 1, 2003. As of that date, respondent had filed a replacement Endorsement for \$3 million, excess of \$2 million, but no replacement Endorsement for the first \$2 million.

Respondent subsequently filed an acceptable \$2 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on July 23, 2003. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
