
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 696 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated without replacement on September 1, 2003, and Certificate No. 696 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 7381, served September 4, 2003.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and an acceptable \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on September 8, 2003. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
