By application accepted for filing October 10, 2003, Fugar Incorporated, a Maryland corporation trading as HKF Transport Service, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for Medicaid and non-Medicaid transportation, including individual fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

Applicant proposes doing business under the trade name, "HKF Transport Service," which the record shows is registered to applicant's president, Henry K. Fugar, instead of applicant. Applicant will be directed to file proof that ownership of the trade name "HKF Transport Service" has been transferred to Fugar Incorporated.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 3, 2003, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 24, 2003, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 3, 2003, an original and four copies of proof that ownership of the trade name "HKF Transport Service" has been transferred to Fugar Incorporated.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 24, 2003, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Henry Kwaku Fugar, 326 Harry S. Truman Drive, Upper Marlboro, MD 20774.
