By application accepted for filing December 15, 2003, Grupo Midlands, Ltd., a Virginia corporation trading as Transportes Izabal CityLines, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one minibus. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an airport transfer rate and an hourly charter rate, with a minimum charge.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 3, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 24, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is February 24, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Dominic Usher, 44084 Riverside Parkway, #LL-350, Lansdowne, VA 20176.
