By application accepted for filing December 22, 2003, Touring Company.com Corporation, a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one minibus. Applicant's proposed tariff contains half-day and full-day charter rates.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 9, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 30, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is March 30, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Chuck Spence, 3900 Sandalwood Court, Fairfax, VA 22031.
