By application accepted for filing February 5, 2004, Carroll's Transportation Services, Inc., a Maryland corporation trading as Carroll's Comfort Lines, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one bus. Applicant's proposed tariff contains charter rates based on hours and miles.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 23, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 13, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 13, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Carroll A. Brown, Jr., P.O. Box 408, Bryans Road, MD 20616.
