By application accepted for filing February 11, 2004, American Easyride Company LLC, a Maryland limited liability company, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains various individual and group rates, including ambulatory van and wheelchair van, as well as exclusive-use and shared-ride rates for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 23, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 13, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 13, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's CEO, Ayodele B. Awowale, 6727 Riverdale Road, #K, Riverdale, MD 20737.
