By application accepted for filing March 5, 2004, Redvan Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant was granted operating authority last year, but the issuance of a certificate of authority was expressly made contingent on applicant filing additional documents.¹ Applicant failed to file the necessary documents in a timely manner, thereby voiding the Commission's approval.²

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains individual fares for transportation between Washington, DC, and various points in the Metropolitan District, plus an hourly group charter rate with a minimum charge.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 22, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.


2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 6, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is May 6, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's CEO, J. Armand Siewe, 6700 Belcrest Road, #517, Hyattsville, MD 20782.
