By application accepted for filing April 7, 2004, Gloria Sodipo, a sole proprietor trading as Right Way Transportation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with three vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program and individual airport shuttle fares, including shuttle fares for transportation between points in Virginia. This Commission does not have jurisdiction over intra-Virginia transportation. Furthermore, although it is customary to offer reduced fares to additional persons traveling in preformed groups, applicant's tariff contains no such reduced fares. Applicant will be directed to file an amended schedule of proposed airport shuttle fares that omits the intra-Virginia fares and indicates to what extent, if any, reduced fares will apply to additional persons traveling in preformed groups.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 7, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.


2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 21, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 7, 2004, an original and four copies of an amended schedule of proposed airport shuttle fares that: (a) omits fares for intra-

Virginia service; and (b) specifies to what extent, if any, reduced fares will apply to additional persons traveling in preformed groups.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is May 21, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant at 5925 Clay Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20019.
