By application accepted for filing April 13, 2004, Hope of Glory Inc., a Maryland corporation trading as Hope of Glory Shuttle, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for Medicaid and non-Medicaid transportation, including individual one-way fares for transportation to Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

Applicant proposes doing business under the trade name, "Hope of Glory Shuttle," which the record shows is registered to applicant's director, Olubunmi Deji Adebajo, instead of applicant. Applicant will be directed to file proof that ownership of the trade name "Hope of Glory Shuttle" has been transferred to Hope of Glory Inc.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 7, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 21, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 21, 2004, an original and four copies of proof that ownership of the trade name "Hope of Glory Shuttle" has been transferred to Hope of Glory Inc.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is May 21, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's director, Olubunmi D. Adebajo, 4605 Sutherland Circle, Upper Marlboro, MD 20772.
