Case No. MP-2004-21 was initiated on January 23, 2004, in Order No. 7690 for the purpose of investigating respondent's failure to file an amended tariff specifying current DC Medicaid rates. The order provided that Certificate No. 729 would stand suspended and be subject to revocation if respondent did not file the amended tariff, pay a filing fee of \$25 and pay a civil forfeiture of \$100, on or before February 22, 2004. Respondent did not comply, and on February 25, 2004, the Commission issued Order No. 7795 noting the suspension of Certificate No. 446 and giving respondent until March 26, 2004, to either file the amended tariff and pay the filing fee and forfeiture assessed in Order No. 7690 or show cause why Certificate No. 446 should not be revoked.

Case No. MP-2004-76 was initiated on March 16, 2004, in Order No. 7863 as a result of respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 7863 noted the suspension of Certificate No. 446 and gave notice that Certificate No. 446 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to reestablish compliance with Regulation No. 58 on or before April 15, 2004.


To date, respondent has neither reestablished compliance with Regulation No. 58 nor complied with any of the orders in these two proceedings. Accordingly, Certificate No. 446 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Article XI, Section 14, of the Compact, Commission Regulations Nos. 55 and 58, and the orders in these proceedings; provided, that the unpaid \$100 annual fee assessed for 2004 pursuant to Order No. 3601 shall remain due and payable; and further provided, that the unfiled 2003 annual report mandated by Commission Regulation No. 60-01 also shall remain due.



THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Cases Nos. MP-2004-21 and MP-2004-76 are hereby consolidated.
2. That Certificate of Authority No. 446 is hereby revoked.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 446 to the Commission.
