
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 126 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on April 20, 2004, and Certificate No. 126 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 7961, served April 20, 2004. Order No. 7961 also noted that respondent had neither paid the \$100 annual fee for 2004¹ nor filed its annual report for 2003.²

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on April 22, 2004, filed its 2003 annual report and paid the 2004 annual fee on May 5, 2004. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
