By application accepted for filing April 20, 2004, applicant, Chariot Transportation, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks Commission approval to acquire Certificate No. 796 from Paul G. Williams. Williams has agreed to transfer Certificate No. 796 and other assets in exchange for a controlling interest in Chariot Transportation, Inc., a new carrier.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

Because the applicant corporation is controlled by transferor Williams, applicant will be directed to file an amended page 3 and Exhibit E of the application.

Article XI, Section 11(a), of the Compact governs the transfer of a certificate of authority in exchange for a controlling interest in a new carrier.¹ A transfer of this nature raises fitness issues only.²

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 10, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 24, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.



3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 10, 2004, an original and four copies of an amended page 3 and Exhibit E of the application.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 24, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Paul G. Williams, P.O. Box 8025, Silver Spring, MD 20907.
