

Notice of this application was served on April 8, 2004, in Order No. 7917, and applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than April 22, 2004, and directed applicant to file proof of publication no later than May 6, 2004. Respondent has yet to file proof of publication.

An application for a certificate of authority must be in writing, verified, and in the form and with the information that Commission regulations require.¹ Commission Regulation No. 54 requires applicants to complete and file the Commission's application form and publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District.² The form itself requires supporting exhibits. Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Elsadig Ibrahim Ali Ibrahim, trading as First Choice Transcare, is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
