By application accepted for filing June 25, 2004, Innovative Life Solutions, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an annual rate for shuttle service under a contract with the District of Columbia's Department of Human Services, Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities Administration (MRDDA).

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 12, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 26, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 26, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's executive director, David Carryington, 3259 O Street, S.E., Washington, DC 20020.
