Revocation of Certificate No. 561)

Certificate No. 561 was automatically suspended on June 6, 2004, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02, for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 8079, served June 8, 2004, noted that Certificate No. 561 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) within thirty days.

A WMATC Insurance Endorsement filed in the name of "Jomo Airport Transportation" on June 10, 2004, was unacceptable for filing because it was incomplete, displayed the wrong carrier name and address, and bore a stamped signature.¹

Accordingly, Certificate No. 561 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Regulation No. 58.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 561 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;

- b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 561 to the Commission.
