Case No. MP-2004-135

Certificate No. 403 was automatically suspended on July 8, 2004, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02, for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 8148, served July 8, 2004, noted that Certificate No. 403 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) within thirty days. Respondent has yet to comply.

In addition, respondent has neither paid the \$100 annual fee for 2004¹ nor filed his annual report for 2003.²

Accordingly, Certificate No. 403 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Regulation No. 58; provided, that the unpaid \$100 annual fee for 2004 shall remain due and payable; and further provided, that the unfiled 2003 annual report also shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That Certificate of Authority No. 403 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
