Case No. MP-2004-157

Certificate No. 512 was automatically suspended on September 12, 2004, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02, for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 8265, served September 14, 2004, noted that Certificate No. 512 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) within thirty days.

On September 22, 2004, the Commission transferred Certificate No. 512 to Quality Medical Supplies LLC, trading as F & J Healthcare Services, pursuant to Order No. 8033, served May 27, 2004, after Quality Medical Supplies had, among other things, filed a \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

Inasmuch as Certificate No. 512 is no longer held by respondent, this proceeding is terminated.
