Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 310 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$4 million excess of \$1 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on February 28, 2005, without replacement, and Certificate No. 310 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 8566, served March 1, 2005. Order No. 8566 also noted that respondent had neither paid the \$100 annual fee for 2005<sup>1</sup> nor filed its annual report for 2004.<sup>2</sup>

On March 3, 2005, respondent filed an acceptable \$4 million excess of \$1 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement, paid the annual fee of \$100 for 2005, and filed its annual report for 2004. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
